## Introduction

## How to use this guide

This guide outlines important considerations when purchasing products and/or services to be funded by EIF. It presents a list of potential suppliers for product and/or services used to complete environment and heritage projects in the Auckland region. We recommend you contact selected suppliers directly and refer to the EIF guidelines booklet for further information.

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## Fencing

Applications for fencing must use a substantial wire fence of 7 or 8 wires properly strained unless an alternative is better suited to the local conditions or land management circumstances. In such cases, an explanation is required and will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Riparian fencing should be positioned a minimum of 10m away from the stream following the topography and contours.

Fencing can generally be purchased for \$15 - \$20 per metre including labour and materials. This costing is for 7 or 8 wire post and batten fencing and depends on the number of angles, strainers and the contour of the land.

We recommend that you refer to the Yellow and White pages to find a fencing contractor in your local area.

## Signage and design

Applications for planting, nature trails etc that request funding for signage must incorporate the ARC logo into the signage design. Please contact the EIF Co-ordinator for ARC logo design files.

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## Native plants

- All plants used in EIF funded projects must be pure native species. EIF does not fund garden cultivars or hybrids. To help you identify pure native plants at a nursery, look at the label. Pure native plants always have a two-part Latin name e.g. *Phormium tenax* (New Zealand flax). Cultivated native plant varieties may have Latin species names attached to English names like "Phormium golden sunrise". Native plant identification books are useful and you can download lists of native plant species that may be suitable for your particular project from the [ARC website](#). If you are unsure about a plant, contact the EIF Co-ordinator.
- All plants must be eco-sourced (see the EIF guidelines booklet, section 12 for more information).
- All plants must be appropriate for the soil, aspect, exposure and topography of the site.
- A plant list is required to be submitted with your application.
- For a full list of EIF native planting special conditions see the EIF guidelines booklet.

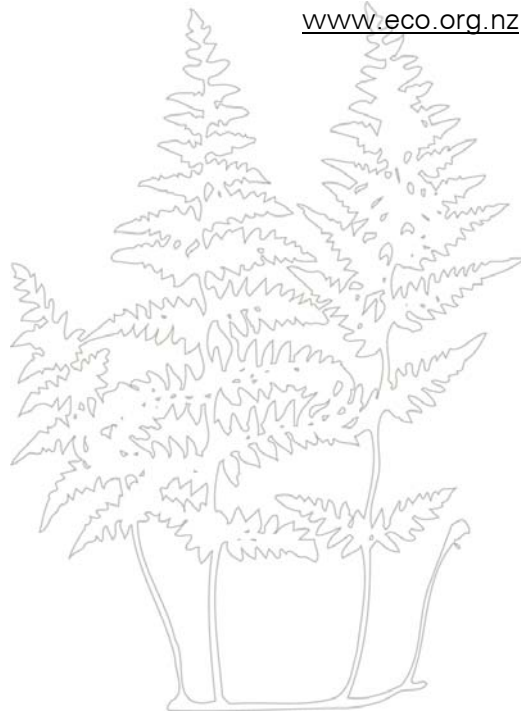

## Covenantee (permanent legal protection of an area)

The ARC is very supportive of the permanent protection of natural areas and cultural heritage sites through legal covenantee with agencies such as Queen Elizabeth II National Trust (QEII). A covenant is a legal agreement registered against the title of a property that protects a specified area or feature. It ensures that no-one in the future can damage or destroy the area you have protected.
