Erosion and Sediment Control: Workshop for Plan Preparers

This 2-day practical workshop - aimed at consultants, covers how estimate sediment yields, prepare erosion and sediment control plans and an assessment of environmental effects that addresses the requirements of the relevant planning documents. It includes two site visits, one to a study site and one to a working site.
