## *Erosion and Sediment Control: Integrated Planning Training Workshop for the Land Development Sector*

This one-day workshop provides further training on preparing Assessments of Environmental Effects (AEEs) and detailed erosion and sediment control plans. The Advanced AEE training course will cover a variety of topics to prepare you in your assessment of environmental effects for earthworks, streamworks and stormwater discharges. This workshop will cover the legal framework of resource consents, the ARC's expectations of preparing assessments of environmental effects and offsetting mitigation.

### The programme includes:

- An analysis of your management and communication processes and how the rules in the RMA and the relevant regional plans affect your sites;
- identifying effects and affected parties;
- a risk assessment approach to ranking the effects and using a toolbox approach to addressing them;
- Using a series of practical activities, including a demo of some readily available 3D software, we show how this information helps you to re-evaluate your proposal, finalise your AEE and carry it through into your erosion and sediment control plan and site communication and management.
