Integrated Catchment Management Plans

A training workshop on writing plans that deliver best value for land use and asset managers

This 1-day practical workshop helps people involved with ICMPs prepare management plans that make it easier for users to action and monitor implementation and outcomes. It builds on previous workshops trialled and endorsed by members of the Regional Stormwater Liaison Group.

This workshop draws on over 12 years of New Zealand-based research into best practice plan preparation – research that has been identified as directly relevant to writing ICMPs.

Attendees gain practical understanding of:

- how best practice research can help with preparing plans that are workable and easy to follow
- the logical links between issues, objectives, methods, indicators and outcomes that a plan needs if it is to deliver best value for council users such as planners and asset managers

Who should attend?

Engineers, asset managers, modellers, planners and related professionals commissioning, writing, using and monitoring the implementation and outcomes of ICMPs will benefit from this workshop.

The workshop will benefit people in the following roles:

- city and district council managers issuing briefs for the engagement of consultants to help them prepare ICMPs
- council managers and staff who are working on preparing ICMPs
- consultants helping councils prepare ICMPs
