Stream Ecological Value Training Workshop

This two day workshop aims to provide specific design guidance for practices outlined in TP302: Stream Ecological Valuation: a method for scoring the ecological performance of Auckland streams and for quantifying mitigation. This recently developed methodology has been adopted as *best practice* for determining environmental compensation requirements for consent applications.

The proposed key topics to be covered in this two-day course are:

- An introduction; philosophy behind model; detailed presentation and discussion of each functional component using the SEV TP report as a template;
- A field application of SEV (excludes fish and macro invertebrate surveys);
- Data analysis and interpretation using field sheets from field assessment;
- Worked examples of applications, focusing on interpretation of results.
